Re: 2018 Pay Claim

Dear Member

Further to the General Meeting on the 22nd of September 2017 of all Mandate members employed by the Law Society of Ireland, it was agreed that the 2018 Pay Claim would comprise of the following:

- 4% Cost of Living Pay Increase for 2018
- Harmonisation of the Annual Leave Entitlements
- Addition of Long Service Increment to the Administrative Pay Scale.

To this end, Mandate wrote to Ms. Maureen Seabrook, Human Resource Manager on 26th September, outlining the terms of our claim. Further to this correspondence a meeting was arranged and duly took place today, with Mr. Ken Murphy, Director General, Ms. Seabrook, the Staff Representatives and the undersigned in attendance.

At the meeting, the grounds supporting our Members claim were clearly outlined and detailed to Mr. Murphy and Ms. Seabrook. It was explained by Mr. Murphy that he would need to bring the details of our claim to the Management sub-committee and the Finance & Administration sub-committee within the Law Society of Ireland for their consideration and response. Mr. Murphy has committed to reverting to the undersigned in a timely manner.
